### **New OGB Dependent Verification Policy A Message From Tommy D. Teague** *OGB Chief Executive Officer*

James works in the cubicle next to yours and is an OGB plan member. For 10 years he has listed Marie as his spouse, faithfully paying his share of their premiums via payroll deduction. The state has funded 50 percent of Marie's premiums and OGB has paid claims for Marie's hip replacement surgery, prescription drugs and other services. Over the years, OGB and plan members such as you have spent thousands of dollars on Marie's health care expenses.

How would you feel if you learned Marie has never been eligible for OGB coverage, because she and James were never legally married?

OGB has approximately 110,000 dependents of plan members enrolled for medical insurance coverage. The state pays 50 percent of the premiums for dependents of active employees and 75 percent for retirees' dependents, but plan members have never had to show proof of dependent status (marriage license or birth certificate) to enroll dependents for OGB coverage.

Nationwide, experts estimate that three to 12 percent of dependents enrolled in unaudited plans, such as OGB, are not eligible for coverage. Although most OGB plan members have listed only eligible dependents, some ineligible dependents are also covered and OGB has a legal obligation to check.

## A Mandate for Change

Government auditors recently noted OGB's oversight in not obtaining verification of plan members' dependents and required OGB to take corrective action this year. To deter fraud and abuse and ensure proper use of public funds and plan members' premium dollars (including yours), OGB now joins the majority of public and private health benefit programs by requiring written proof of dependency for all covered dependents.

OGB has implemented a new policy that requires all current active and retired employees to provide written proof that each dependent you now cover or want to add is your actual legal dependent.

During April 2008, OGB plan members can voluntarily drop ineligible dependents from coverage with no questions asked and no penalties. Between August 1, 2008, and November 30, 2008, all employees must present appropriate written verification to their agency for all currently covered dependents. Retirees will mail copies of documents directly to OGB. Members who fail to submit proof will have dependent coverage terminated effective December 31, 2008.

We know this is a complex issue and may cause our plan members some inconvenience. To make the process easier, we are mailing you instructions explaining what to do if you have covered dependents.

We urge you to review and comply with this policy. The consequences for failing to do so are significant and can easily be avoided.

## Hospital-Based Providers: In-Network or Out?

OGB and our plan administrators, Humana and UnitedHealthcare, strive to control costs and provide broad, comprehensive networks of participating health care providers for members enrolled in the PPO, EPO and HMO plans. We offer our network providers fair, competitive reimbursement and prompt, accurate claims payment. For their own business reasons, however, some providers choose not to enter into contracts to become participating providers for some health care plans.

The situation is difficult for plan members when providers who choose not to participate are hospital-based ancillary service providers in medical specialties such as pathology, radiology, anesthesiology and emergency medicine. In the past, such providers were sometimes reimbursed

at a higher rate, which meant the member's outof-pocket costs were the same as using a network provider. However, paying non-participating providers more is unfair to network providers who agreed to accept reimbursement at lower contracted network rates.

For this reason, OGB now pays member claims submitted by ALL non-network providers, including hospital-based ancillary service providers, at out-of-network rates—even if the hospital or facility is a network provider for the member's plan. This results in higher out-ofpocket expenses for plan members who use outof-network providers. OGB urges our plan members to manage out-of-pocket costs by checking in advance to be sure hospital-based providers are participating providers in your plan.

## PLAN OF BENEFITS

#### Notice to OGB Retirees Who Reached Age 65 On or After July 1, 2005

If you are eligible for premium-free Medicare Part A (hospitalization insurance), you MUST also enroll in Medicare Part B (medical insurance) to receive OGB benefits on Medicare Part B claims.

• This does not apply to you if you reached age 65 before July 1, 2005.

• If you are retired, but not yet age 65, this will apply to you when you reach age 65.

• If you reached age 65 on or after July 1, 2005, but have not retired, this will apply to you when you retire.

• This applies to you and your covered spouse regardless of whether each of you has individual Medicare eligibility (under your own Social Security number) or one of you is eligible as the dependent of the other.

If you are **not** eligible for premium-free Medicare Part A, this does not apply to you. However, you must provide OGB with written verification of ineligibility from the Social Security Administration.





## OGB's PPO Plan of Benefits will reflect several changes effective May 1, 2008

As always, for specific PPO plan language, please refer to the official OGB Plan Document, which is available on the OGB website (www.groupbenefits.org).

• **Durable Medical Equipment** – There will no longer be a separate \$50,000 lifetime limit on benefits for durable medical equipment such as wheelchairs and hospital beds.

• Ambulance Services – The separate benefits limitations (\$350 for ground transportation and \$1,500 for air transportation), as well as the separate copayments (\$50 for ground transportation and \$250 for air transportation) will be removed. Benefits for ambulance services (transportation, medical services, and supplies) will be determined in accordance with the Preferred Provider Organization fee schedule.

• Physician Assistants and Registered Nurse Practitioners – These providers will be reimbursed at 80 percent of the amounts payable for the same services rendered by a physician.

• Genetic Testing – The general exclusion for genetic testing is being changed to allow benefits for procedures determined to be medically necessary for certain conditions.

## **IMPORTANT REMINDER**

Participants in OGB dependent care or health care flexible spending accounts must re-enroll each plan year. The deadline to re-enroll is May 16, 2008.
