

Lincecum elected to SALGBA Board of Directors

Office of Group Benefits Deputy Undersecretary Hubert Lincecum was recently elected to the Board of Directors of the State and Local Government Benefits Association (SALGBA). He will serve a three-year term, which runs through spring 2011. Lincecum was also named chair of the SALGBA Member Services and Internal Communications Committee.

SALGBA is a national organization whose members consist of municipal, county and state government employee benefits professionals. Its purpose is to provide members with educational programs and networking opportunities.

Lincecum has been employed at OGB for nearly 30 years. He previously served for 13 years as legislative director for the Louisiana Public Employees Council #17 AFSCME-AFL-CIO, lobbying the Louisiana Legislature for employee benefits.
