### Nationwide Alert Issued on Counterfeit One Touch® Basic®/Profile® and One Touch® Ultra® Blood Glucose Test Strips

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and LifeScan, Inc., are alerting the public to counterfeit blood glucose test strips being sold in the United States for use with various models of LifeScan One Touch® brand blood glucose monitors used by people with diabetes to measure their blood glucose.

The counterfeit test strips could potentially give incorrect blood glucose values—either too high or too low—which might result in a patient taking either too much or too little insulin and lead to serious injury or death.

The outer cartons of the recently discovered counterfeit test strips have <u>all</u> of the following characteristics:

### **Counterfeit OneTouch Ultra Test Strips**

Lot Numbers 2691191 and 2691261 (located on outer carton and vial)

#### Characteristics:

- Multiple Languages: English and French text on the outer carton;
- Lot number located on outer carton and vial;
- Limited to 50-Count OneTouch Ultra Test Strip packages; and
- No NDC number (located on the bottom of the outer carton for U.S. products)

## Lot Number 2615211 *Characteristics:*

- English text on the outer carton
- Limited to 50-Count OneTouch (Basic/Profile) Test Strip packages
