



New Pharmacy Plan for OGB Members

MedImpact Healthcare Systems, Inc. will begin providing pharmacy benefit management (PBM) services to Louisiana Office of Group Benefits (OGB) members January 1, 2014. MedImpact is the nation's largest full-service pharmacy benefit manager, serving more than 35 million members across the U.S. Under the new contract, MedImpact will provide prescription drug coverage for the more than 220,000 benefit-eligible employees, retirees and dependents enrolled in the OGB HMO and PPO health plans administered by Blue Cross and Blue Shield (BCBS) of Louisiana.

Medicare-eligible retirees and their Medicare-eligible dependents will be covered by Medicare GenerationRx (Employer PDP), provided through MedImpact's subsidiary, MedGenerations, effective January 1, 2014. Your previous coverage will continue through December 31, 2013.

You will receive a new ID card in the mail in December that you can use at your pharmacy beginning in January. Remember to show this new card to your pharmacy so your medications will be covered.

IMPORTANT: If you are a Medicare-eligible retiree, your enrollment in Medicare GenerationRx will automatically cancel your enrollment in a different Medicare prescription drug plan or a Medicare Advantage plan. That's why you will receive a disenrollment letter from Express Scripts Medicare. But don't worry, **there will be no interruption in your coverage.** You will be covered by Express Scripts Medicare through December 31, 2013, and will be covered by Medicare GenerationRx starting January 1, 2014. You do not have to do anything.
