



OGB Cautions Members Against Scams

The Office of Group Benefits (OGB) has received reports from members who have been called or had a door-to-door solicitation from individuals claiming to be affiliated with OGB. In many cases, these solicitors call themselves “OGB Benefit Advisors” and ask for money to be sent directly to them in order to enroll in a health plan. It’s important to remember that **OGB representatives will never come to your home and will never ask you to send money directly to the agency or a representative.** If you receive a suspicious call, visit or letter, please contact OGB to confirm that it is legitimate.
