**Medicare Enrollment Continues until Feb. 28 for Louisianans Affected by  
Recent Weather-Related Disasters**

Louisiana residents affected by recent weather-related disasters will have more time to make their Medicare healthcare decisions, per updated guidelines from the U.S. Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS).

The Medicare Special Enrollment Period (SEP) began on Oct. 26, 2020, and is available through Feb. 28, 2021. To be eligible for the SEP, an individual must have been eligible to enroll in a Medicare plan at some point during this period, but was unable to do so because of recent weather-related disasters. The SEP is also available to people who weren't affected, but rely on friends or family for making healthcare decisions who were affected.
